### **College Times:**

Tuesday Evenings – 6:45 pm – 9:30pm from Tuesday February 21<sup>st</sup> (TBC) 2023.  
There will be four terms, each with 8 weeks.

### **College Fees:**

\$200 per term due before the beginning of terms, or annual fee of \$800.  
Due dates before 14<sup>th</sup> Feb 2023 or School of Ministry Payment plans available but must be requested before Payment due date.

### **Semester One (Term 1 and Term 2)**

Orientation: Tuesday Night February 14<sup>th</sup> 7:00pm  
All Formation (Year 1) and Leadership (Year 2) students will undertake Emotionally Healthy Discipleship Course (EHD)  
(16 weeks in total, completed together as a FSM College Body)

This will be covered over Term 1 and Term 2 -7pm-8:45pm each Tuesday  
Followed by 9pm-9:30pm Formation / Leadership Subject

### **Semester Two (Term 3 and Term 4)**

Tuesday nights 6:30pm – 9:30pm

Two subjects and Tutorial each night

FSM Program also includes:

- Mentor Program -Practical Service/ Ministry
- Prayer Times -Retreats

### **Attendance Requirements:**

**All School of Ministry functions, Freedom Centre Sunday Services as well as any events** as declared by the college require 100% attendance except with notification/permission from the Principal or Dean from Feb 21st to end of November.

During this period, you are considered a student of Freedom School of Ministry in training.

### **Retreats:**

Please Note: Attendance at Retreats is Compulsory

**College Overseas Trip:** Not compulsory but highly recommended -Trip to Port Vila Mid-late July 2023

### **Lectures + Assessments:**

-All subjects require 80% attendance to pass.

-All assignments must be completed by their due date, Submission times set by trainers, negotiable with them or by appeal to the principal but must be done before the due date.

**Study Load:** As a Freedom School of Ministry Student you will be expected to dedicate adequate time to the requirements of all the subjects into which you are enrolled.

The Expected Study Load per subject is approximately **1.5-2 Hours** per week

**Max. 50 Min** of Face-to-Face Class Time

**.5 - 1.5 Hours** Out of Class Private Study Time (This Includes readings, homework, and completion of assessments)

As a student you can expect to dedicate between **4-6 Hours** of work per week (Includes Class Time) to adequately fulfill the Academic requirements and your learning.

### **Freedom School of Ministry Practical:**

As a Formation Student of FSM you will be required to be take part in Practical Service as well as classes, overall every Student will be expected to complete approximately 4-6hrs of practical ministry per week which includes:

- Sunday Service Serving (Approx. 2hrs a week) - This can be in groups you are already serving in if they run on a Sunday, however as a FSM we want to give you some type of role that you can take ownership of - So these will be assigned by discussion with yourself, Freedom School of Ministry and Freedom Centre

- Mentorship Program: Students will be required to take part in the FSM Mentorship Program where you are required to meet with a mentor of your choice fortnightly for 30mins
- FSM Practical Ministry – During the week where you will be assigned certain practical responsibilities, these responsibilities will be in line with your Sunday serving or for the behind the scenes operation of Freedom Ministry/Centre

It is our hope that by partaking in this program you will receive a better understanding of how you can translate what you learn in the classroom into everyday ministry while developing the type of relationship which is vital in the Kingdom of God.

**Dress Code: (Can be changed)**

**College:** Neat and casual to church.
